

BSNLEU goes to Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh on grant of Recognition to NFTE : A BSNLEU Branch Secretary in AP has gone to Court seeking quashing of orders issued on 19.5.2016 granting Recognition to NFTE with prayers that [1] 50% of Votes for Recognition as a sole recognized Union should be on the basis the polled votes and not on the Total votes and [2] the Secretary and President of the National, Circle and Local Councils of the Staff side should be elected by the JCM members and not as stipulated in Recognition Rules.

This case is filed in spite of the Judgments of Honorable Madras High Court and J&K High Court that 50% of the votes should be calculated on the Total Votes and not on the polled votes. Already membership verification was conducted in 2013 on the basis of the New Recognition Rules and now BSNLEU wants to tailor the Rules to suit its needs.

This case is filed on the advice of GS, BSNLEU. On the night of the counting day itself, it was reliably learnt that, he had held consultations on filing a case.
