**Subject:-** Promotion to the Cadre of Junior Engineer (T) on seniority – Cum fitness basis – reg.

Respected Madam,

Kind reference is invited on the aforesaid item.

In the 35<sup>th</sup> National Council meeting we have demanded that out of 50% quota departmental quota vacancies 15% be earmarked for promotion of Telecom Technicians (Formerly Telecom Mechanics) for promotion to Junior Engineer (Telecom) Cadre. If we recollect on our pleadings you agreed and desired that the matter be considered in real perspective. However, things have not moved till date and hence this reference.

We may submit that promotion to SDE Cadre from JTO is on seniority cum fitness basis as well through examination without affecting the quality of service. A question arises why the same yardstick cannot be applied in respect of non-executive staff in promotion you will agree instead of discrimination similar treatment is needed. It is well known that presently Assistant Telecom Technicians (formerly RMs) and Telecom Technician (Earlier TMS) are stagnating in the present scale. If this reasonable demand is accepted it will help in addressing the stagnation problem upto some extent.

Under the circumstances we implore upon you to please get the matter favourably considered.
